

Commanders Message



Tax Deductible Donation

By the way, Veteran car donations are 100% tax deductible. In fact, if a donated vehicle sells for less than \$500, you can claim the fair market value. If the vehicle sells for more than \$500, you can claim the sale amount.

How to Donate to Vehicles for Veterans and Claim your Tax Deduction

Call Vehicles for Veterans at 1-877-646-1976 or fill out their online donation form. They will reach out within one business day to arrange your free vehicle pick-up. The tow truck arrives, and your vehicle is towed. You will receive a receipt for the sale of your vehicle in the mail.

receive your approval email, you can start the search for your new best friend! Qualified applicants must:


- Have completed a minimum of 190 days of military service after basic training.
- Provide proof of service.


Patriots for Pets, Too
