On another note...... Did you know, that the majority of your annual American Legion Membership fees goes directly to the National American Legion Organization. Your local Legion post, the George F. Lamm Post gets very little to put towards the Post's operating expenses and programs. For the 2025 Membership year, the dues were raised by five dollars, but the Lamm Post maintained last years rate in an effort to help its members. This leaves even less for the post to operate on.

The majority of expenses for the Lamm Post are paid through the Enterprise side of the post. The main revenue is generated by the rental of the main manor hall, the lounge and the grove. These rentals must have help and supervision of post members, which is a volunteer situation. Currently, there are only a "handful" of dedicated volunteers that assist at these events. 


