

# All Female Flight Buffalo-Niagara Honor Flight October 2025



## Veteran & Guardian Application Overview

Buffalo-Niagara Honor Flight, a hub of the National Honor Flight Network, recognizes United States veterans for their sacrifices and achievements by flying them to Washington, D.C. for an overnight trip to see service memorials at no cost. World War II veterans are given top priority, followed by Korean War veterans, and then Vietnam War veterans, and those with terminal illnesses. Veterans serving during those eras are eligible. Applicants will be reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Veterans are accompanied by a guardian, an able-bodied adult who assists the veteran throughout the trip ensuring veterans have a safe and memorable experience. This may be a friend or family member. All guardians must complete a Guardian Application. If a family member or friend is not available, the Buffalo-Niagara Honor Flight organization will gladly provide a guardian. For this All-Female flight, only female guardians are permitted.

Guardians are responsible to pay a fee that covers their expenses for the two-day trip. The fee will be assessed prior to the flight and MUST be paid two weeks prior to the flight. Check or cash are accepted. Anticipated fee is approximately \$475.

If you have any medical changes (including prescriptions) between the time of your application and your confirmed Mission, please let us know right away.
